



EURORDIS 2013 Photo Contest

Terms & Conditions

- The “EURORDIS 2013 Photo Contest” is organised by EURORDIS, the European Organisation for Rare Diseases.
- The competition is open to anyone with an interest in rare diseases.
- The contest starts on 25 September 2013. All photos must be submitted by 15 December 2013. Any photos submitted after this date will not be considered for the contest.
- Photos must be submitted by completing the entry form available at <http://www.eurordis.org/photo-contest-2013>, or by sending entries to photocontest@eurordis.org with the following information: first name of the person(s) photographed, country, disease(s) represented, name of the photographer, title of the photo, and eventual comments.
- The minimal resolution must be 2048 x 1360 pixels in 300 dpi.
- The photos submitted must not have received any prizes in other competitions.
- EURORDIS reserves the right to disqualify photos which it believes are not genuinely obtained i.e. believed to be not taken by the named entrant.
- EURORDIS reserves the right to disqualify entries if fraudulent activity is suspected during the voting process.
- An unlimited number of pictures may be sent per entrant, but EURORDIS reserves the right to place on the Photo Gallery as many photos as it wishes.
- [All prizes](#) will be awarded once a final decision has been reached. The winners will be notified by the most convenient method available.
- Winners will be announced 26 December 2013 according to the [contest's procedures](#); the jury's decision is final.
- Copyright of submitted images will rest with the photographer. However, entry into the competition will permit unrestricted use of the images by EURORDIS for communication purposes, including Rare Disease Day (website, newsletter, brochures, leaflets, posters, etc.).
- EURORDIS will not release photos to third/outside sources
- Photos must be free of any rights of third parties. The photographer must possess sole rights of use of the photos submitted.
- If the person(s) portrayed in the photo (or the family) does/do not want the photo to be used for public communication any more, it will stop being used further by EURORDIS. However, previously produced communication supports will be used until out of stock.
- Employees of EURORDIS and their families, members of EURORDIS' Board and their families, and members of the jury and their families are not allowed to enter the contest.
- Participating and entering this contest is considered a complete release of Facebook by each entrant or participant. It is also an acknowledgement that the contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook.
- Participants are providing information to EURORDIS and not to Facebook
- Entering the competition implies acceptance of these rules.
